

Care and Maintenance Instructions

Cleaning Guidelines

Avoid rain, adverse weather conditions, and car washes for 72 hours after installation.

Substances such as tree sap, bird droppings, salt spray, insects, tar, oils, etc. should be cleaned immediately to preserve the life of the film.



Cleaning Materials

Use a clean microfiber cloth to prevent scratching of the film in conjunction with ammonia-free glass cleaner or a mild solution of dish soap and water.

Maintenance Wipes

Help extend the lifespan of Windshield Skin with specially formulated maintenance wipes. Use every six to eight washes to help maintain Windshield Skin's clear, transparent appearance for time to come.

Step 1: Use Packet 1 to clean the surface of the Windshield Skin.

Step 2: Use Packet 2 to apply the specially formulated coating. This step resurfaces the hard coat and hydrophobic properties of the Windshield Skin.

Avoiding Product Damage

Avoid sharp objects and direct high-pressure water. **Do NOT** use hard brushes or harsh chemicals.

Proper Wiper Care

The use of dry windshield wipers (without the presence of precipitation or windshield washer fluid) can damage or scratch the film.

Consider replacing your wipers if you see this on your windshield.
